Sporysz Joseph 30 single laborer going to Uncle Joseph Gruczala address faint in (supposedly, all say Detroit) Detroit were you ever in US before? yes (left US on) Aug 1917 place of birth Poland Osick 5 ft 10 in complexion rudy hair dark eyes brown

WWI US draft registration: born in Wies Osiek

[Note: there are about 30 Osiek villages in Poland.]

from the PGSA in Chicago: \$5.00 to copy Haller's Army record for him

Sporysz did not fight with the Canadian army or Russian army, but with Haller's Army, who were Polish-Americans. A group of them returned on the above ship Pocahontas on said date 1920
